The 2018 Biomedical Research Equipment and Supplies Exhibit at Fort Detrick

More than 1,000 purchasing agents, primary investigators and their laboratory staff from NCI/Fort Detrick’s 25 tenant organizations representing the Army, Navy, Air Force, and Marines and NCI’s Frederick Cancer Research Facility will attend. Neighboring research institutions and off-site government agencies will also be invited. The combined research budgets of NCI-Frederick and Fort Detrick exceeds \$750 million. Fort Detrick’s 2017 research contract expenditures for equipment, supplies and services totaled \$8 million. With the federal government’s renewed commitment to funding biomedical research, 2017 forecasts increased spending within the Fort Detrick community.

The 2017 exhibit featured nearly 200 booths presented by more than 180 regional and national suppliers. The 2018 exhibit predicts a repeat sell-out with increased vendor participation. The premier combined exhibit/technical program along with an extensive promotion campaign (including e-mail, advertisements and an on-site give away item) promises a record attendance. The 2018 Biomedical Research Equipment and Supplies Exhibit at Fort Detrick is your most direct entree to a target audience of decision makers from the world’s foremost microbiological containment research community. In light of the increased security measures installed at Ft. Detrick, this may be your best and only opportunity to gain access to this prestigious purchasing network.
